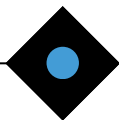

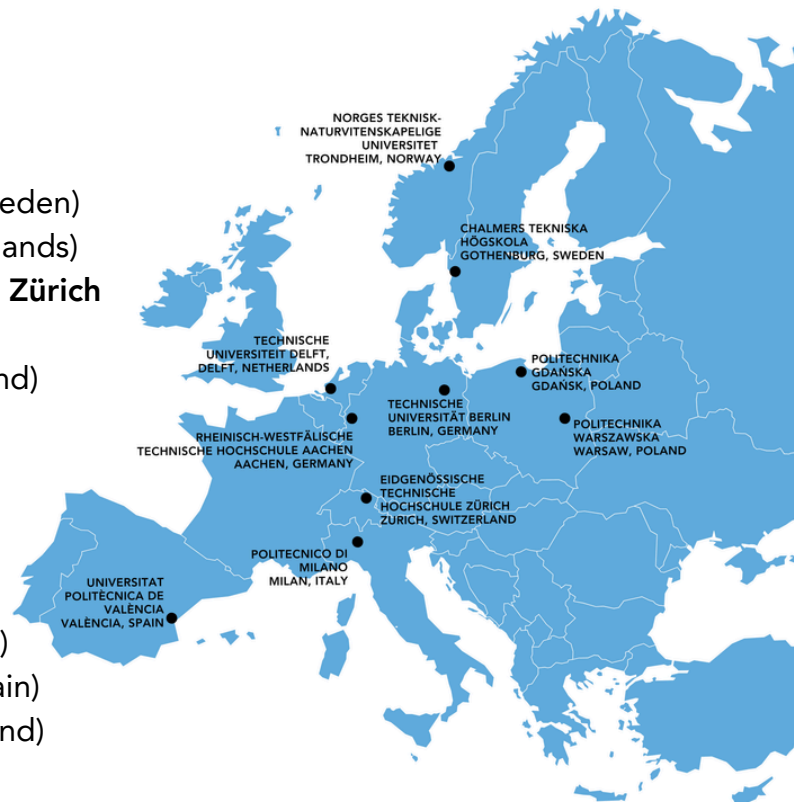
The ENHANCE Alliance

What Is a Blended Intensive Programme?

Blended Intensive Programmes (BIPs) are short, intensive learning formats developed within a Europe-wide initiative to foster innovative, flexible, and inclusive mobility in higher education. They combine a brief period of physical mobility abroad with a compulsory virtual component, enabling intensive international learning experiences within a compact timeframe and supporting new forms of transnational academic cooperation in teaching and learning.

ENHANCE Blended Intensive Programmes are jointly developed and implemented by a consortium of at least three ENHANCE partner universities. One institution acts as coordinator and hosts the physical in-presence phase, while partner institutions contribute to programme design, teaching activities, and participant engagement.

Each ENHANCE BIP consists of a 5–10 day physical mobility phase that brings learners and teachers together in person, complemented by a virtual component that enables structured, collaborative online work. The virtual component may take place before and/or after the physical phase and is an integral part of the overall learning design and intended learning outcomes.

ENHANCE BIPs may be open to students and/or staff and aim to support pedagogical innovation and high-quality teaching and learning across institutional and disciplinary boundaries within the European University Alliance framework.

Purpose of This Call and Application Form

This document outlines the framework and requirements for proposing jointly developed ENHANCE Blended Intensive Programmes in the upcoming funding phase. It serves as a common reference for academic staff interested in initiating or participating in collaborative BIP initiatives within the ENHANCE Alliance. The call aims to support high-quality, innovative programme concepts that contribute to ENHANCE's strategic objectives and strengthen European cooperation in teaching and learning.

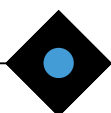
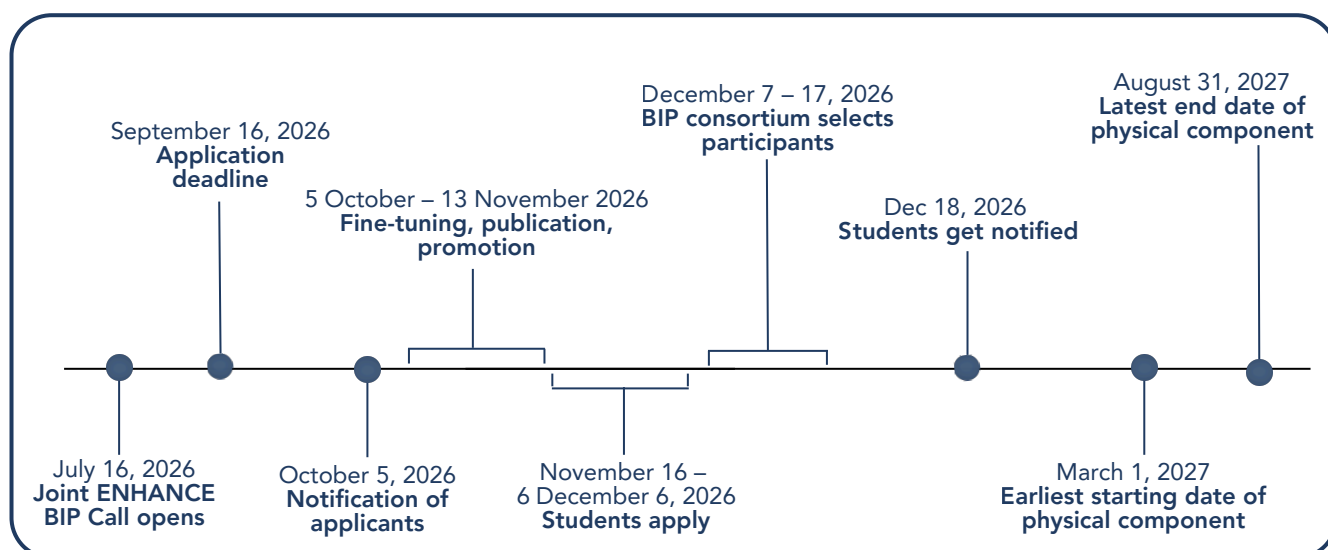
Requirements

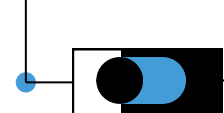
- The BIP consortium must include at least 3 ENHANCE universities in 3 different countries (if ETH Zurich is the coordinator, 2 ENHANCE universities (ETH + 1 partner) in 2 different countries is sufficient).
- Proposals must follow the programme structure virtual + 5-10 days physical component (5 days being the recommended length).
- Award at least 3 ECTS.
- A minimum number of 10 learners receiving an Erasmus+ scholarship ("Erasmus+ mobile learners") need to participate in the programme (we recommended to plan with at least 25-30 learners).

Funding

BIP funding is composed of organisational support funds for the coordinating university plus mobility scholarships for teachers and learners participating in the physical component/in-presence phase. The total amount of funding depends on the number of learners enrolled in the BIP and the institution-specific regulations of the involved partners.

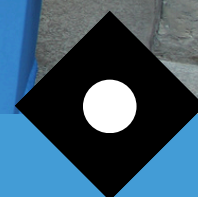
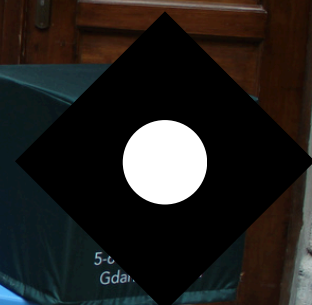
