## WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?

Micro-credentials are an essential part of the ENHANCE joint educational offer. They are viewed as a means to make it more flexible and attractive, not only to traditional students on bachelor, master, or doctoral degree programmes but also to various groups of lifelong learners.

Some of the ENHANCE micro-credentials are in process. They will be developed jointly with industry partners, local governments, and non-profit organisations to meet the needs of different stakeholders.

of learner participation (they may depend on other modes of delivery), including: on-campus,

- online,
- •blended (combining obligatory on-campus and online components),
- hybrid (allowing to select on-campus or online participation).


